As we approach the end of the liturgical year, our readings offer a sober reminder that this life is not our aim and that God's justice will triumph in the end. Now is the time to get our priorities in order, putting God above all else as his faithful stewards.

Our Lord brings home the urgency of right priorities in our Gospel passage from Luke, reminding the people around him who were looking at the temple nearby, "All that you see here—the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down." Our Lord reminds us that all in this world is passing. We must keep our focus on eternity.

Yet before the eternal bliss of heaven, we should expect to be tried and tested. "Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you, they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons and they will have you led before kings and governors because of my name." Sounds scary.

But if you are living a stewardship way of life, there is nothing to fear. You have a plan in place. All you need to do is stick with it. Put our Lord first in your time, with your talents, and through your use of treasure. This way of life is not easy. But Jesus promises it will lead to eternal salvation and the joy of union with Him. "You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance, you will secure your lives." Onward Christian stewards, the struggle is worth the joy that awaits!

# St. Jude Thaddeus

Feast Day: October 28

## Did you know:

- St. Jude was the brother of James, the Less and a relative of Jesus. He was one of the 12 Apostles.
- St. Jude is not the same person as Judas Iscariot.
- The flame around his head represents his presence at Pentecost, when he accepted the Holy Spirit along with the other apostles.
- Two saints, St. Bridget of Sweden and St. Bernard, had visions from God asking them to accept St. Jude as "The Patron Saint of the Impossible."
- Catholics invoke St. Jude when in desperate situations because his New Testament letter stresses that the faithful should persevere in the environment of harsh, difficult circumstances - therefore, he is the patron saint of desperate cases.

As we celebrate the feast day of St. Jude, let us ask for his intercession as we strive to build God's Church, making his presence known to all.

# St. Elizabeth of Hungary

Feast Day: November 17

## Did you know:

- St. Elizabeth was born into nobility. She used her royal nobility to advance her mission for charity. She had a hospital built and provided for almost a thousand poor people daily.
- St. Elizabeth mirrored her life in imitation of St. Francis of Assisi. She and her husband were very generous to the poor.
- After Elizabeth's husband died, she vowed to never remarry and to live a life similar to a nun.
- Elizabeth joined the Third Order of St. Francis. She was deeply devoted to God and to caring for the poor. She died on November 17, 1231 at the age of 24.
- She is the patron saint of bakers, beggars, brides, charities, death of children, homeless people, hospitals, Sisters of Mercy and widows.
   She is often depicted with a basket of bread to show her devotion to the poor and hungry.

As we celebrate the feast day of St. Elizabeth, let us ask for her intercession as we strive to build God's Church, making His presence known to all.
