

Prison Ministry

Dear parishioners,

As you know, prison ministry has really become a great calling for several of St. Jude and St Elizabeth Parishioners. Besides Holy Mass, Communion service, and rosary offered to Century prison Thursdays and Sundays, and writing letters to inmates, we have been involved in three day long Catholic retreats which took place in Aug of '23 and this last week at Century under the banner of St. Maximilian Kolbe, therefore named Kolbe Retreats. Our first retreat had 24 participants, and the one this last week had 40!! Of course, a bit of the draw for these men is the GREAT FOOD. However, the men who have been attending weekly services have spread the word of how spiritual and soul strengthening the retreat was last time and would be this time as well. What every one of them takes away is our love, Jesus' love, and strength in their Catholic faith and hope. Hope which is a scant feeling in prison. Our portion of the team, the ones who are making and delivering the food are Rose and John Veverka, Andy Bonifay, and Chris and Mark O'Hara shown in the picture. Rose and John pre prepared most of the meals and Chris and Mark pre prepared her spaghetti sauce and then St. Jude's parish hall was used to heat the meals to be delivered by Andy to the prison. A big thank you to our wonderful team, including Theresa Cash, who worked for weeks to, in the end, provide 450 meals, with approximately 65 hours of food prep. A big thank you to Father George, who celebrated Mass and attended to the needs of those involved each day of the retreat.

World Day of the Sick


February 11th is World Day of the Sick, an observation introduced by St. Pope John Paul II as a way for
