Dear St. Jude and St. Elizabeth Parish Family:

I pray that the peace of Christ has been with you these past few months and remains with you always! This fourth Sunday of lent, also called Laetare Sunday meaning "rejoice", appeared to be the best time to share news that is joyful.

As you know, I left seminary briefly in October and November for my own personal reasons. By divine providence, I was away for approximately forty days and forty nights. In that time, I discerned and still felt called to priesthood. After talking with the vocation's director and with the bishop's approval, I was accepted back as a seminarian.

Currently, I'm in my propaedeutic year but I am fulfilling it at Good Shepherd Catholic Parish in Tallahassee where there are sufficient resources to aid in my human and spiritual formation. This year, I've studied and reflected on prayer; developing an intimate relationship with Jesus Christ; rooted my identity in the truth as a beloved adopted son of God; ministered to the homeless and imprisoned; and I have been a youth leader for the parish's Life Teen ministry.

After May 24<sup>th</sup>, I will be at the summer formation house again and then I will begin my first discipleship year which was formally called pre-theology. The two years of discipleship involve philosophical education at the seminary.

As I come to a close on my first year as a seminarian, I want to thank you abundantly for your prayers and support. There isn't a day that goes by that I do not think about you all and I'm praying for you as well. Please continue to pray for me as I progress through formation.

May the mercy of Jesus Christ continue to pour out on you each day this lent as we make our homecoming journey to Easter!
