Religious Education Ministry

RCIA-Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Each class session is a process of teaching the Catholic religion to any individual who has the desire to gather information based on the Catholic teaching to enrich & embrace a stronger understanding of the Catholic faith and incorporate into their daily lives. The Goal of RCIA is to bring individuals into a relationship with Christ through a sacramental formation process. Class sessions are taught by various individuals who devote and donate their time and efforts to anyone who attends. Each class lasts an hour and sessions run 30-34 weeks. Zoom is also available.

CCD-Confraternity of Christian Doctrine simply Catechism Each year there is a "Welcome" party to kick off the new

year. We have a "meet & greet" between teachers, students, & parents. On this day, all paperwork is explained & completed according to the Diocese requirements.

All teachers have a background check & fingerprinted to ensure that all our students are safe from harm. Class sessions are arranged by grade, age, & individual competencies. Group teachings & special sessions as well as classroom settings are ways the Catholic teachings are delivered to the students. There is always a Huge need for Teachers. At the present, we have 3 individuals who have volunteered to help teach the children who are the future of the church. The First Friday Rosary started pre-Covid and ceased during Covid 19. It was resurrected later and it is still going. Pre-Covid there was actually a portable campfire and then a kerosene lantern. Now we meet every First Friday of the month at various locations. The most popular location is St. Elizabeth's parking lot between the church and the graveyard. Some come early to pay respect to friends that have passed. We bring lawn chairs (don't worry we bring extras) and sit in a circle and those that desire announce intentions that we will pray for during the Rosary. The 'campfire' consists of a very large candle which is easier to transport. After the Rosary many people stay and socialize.

If the weather is bad we go inside the church. All are welcome to come and pray the Holy Rosary with us! Our next Rosary is Friday, June 7th at St. Elizabeth at 7:00 pm.

- 4. Building Project Joan Wallace reported on the progress. The builders received the 35% drawing of the design phase. The Architect is 90% complete with plans. When the parishioners gathered to vote for the colors and floor for the new building, most chose the same colors for the new building. There will be a Town Hall on June 23. The builder will be present to answer questions. There will be schematic drawings as well as site maps and renderings of the building.
- 5. Knights of Columbus Report The Knights handled parking and beverage sales at the Music Fest. Plans are under way for the Christmas Raffle.
- 6. Ladies Group St. Jude Lynn Sonderman. The Ladies are on summer break. They are planning the annual Belk Day Certificate sales.
- 7. Maintenance/upkeep St. Jude Mark O'Hara, St. Elizabeth Chuck Strahota. There was a discussion of preventative maintenance and reporting for all items that need checked. The Knights will discuss developing and implementing a preventive maintenance schedule for St. Jude
- 8. New Business There was a discussion about changing the format for the financial reports in the weekly bulletin. In addition to what we already publish, the total monthly income and expenses for each church will also be posted in the bulletin.
- 9. Father's Report The implementation of the plan for creating a prayerful environment before mass at St. Jude has been going well. There was a discussion about the Grab-n-Go fundraiser. In 22 months we have had 8 Grab-n-Go's and have raised \$10,671.00. We have had one No Bake Bake Sale raising \$1153.00. We have had 48 Concession stands raising \$43,654.54. We have had 2 Mardi Gras parties raising \$2605.00. We have had 2 Octoberfest's raising \$3582.00. We have had 1 Restaurant Night

raising \$147.98. Our Amazon Smile total is \$239.49 and our profit from the St. Jude & St. Elizabeth blue t-shirts is \$250.00. Our Music Fest raised \$11,474.75. Some members shared that we are focusing only on our parish and suggested that we need to reach out to the wider community. It was decided to pause the Grab-n-Go meals until September. Rachel Bradley and Barbara Korinchak agreed to organize a Grab-n-Go for the wider community. There was a discussion about the disposition of the stage. We purchased the stage with the intention of using it for our festivals and activities and renting it out. As per the Diocesan insurance policy, we are unable to rent it out and so a few members of our parish decided to buy the stage from the church at the same amount we paid for the stage and they will rent it out and the proceeds will go to the St. Jude and St. Elizabeth Building Fund. The Parish Council agreed to sell the stage. There was an evaluation of the Music Festival and the council members shared the accomplishments and the areas needed for improvement when we have another festival. There will be more discussion about it after the music festival core group of volunteers evaluation on 5/31/24.

Next meeting is 7/23 at St. Elizabeth. Father closed with a prayer.





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
