
Weddings: Call the parish office to schedule first meeting with the Pastor at least 6 months in advance.

### LENT

The holy season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5th. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence.

\*When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Everyone age 18 or older and under 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

\*Everyone 14 year of age or older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

Each Friday during Lent, beginning on March 7th, Friday Mass will be at 5:30 pm followed by Stations of the Cross at St. Jude. On First Fridays, the rosary will be said after Stations of the Cross.

Ash Wednesday Mass at St. Elizabeth will be at 8:30 AM Ash Wednesday Mass at St. Jude will be at 6:00 PM

#### Silver Rose Mass and Rosary

We will have a Silver Rose Mass and Rosary on Wednesday, March 18th at 5:00 PM. The Silver Rose commemorates Saint Juan Diego and the miracle of the roses. Each year, eight roses run along different North American routes that include Canada, every U.S. state, Puerto Rico, the District of Columbia, and Mexico. This tradition spreads devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe and is a rosary-centered occasion to pray for respect for life, the spiritual renewal of each nation, and the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe.
