Holy Thursday is the anniversary of the Institution of the Sacred Priesthood. The spiritual formation and education of future priests for the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee are of utmost importance. A collection will be taken on Holy Thursday, April 17, for this purpose.

Good Friday, April 18, is the annual Pontifical Good Friday

What is the Chrism Mass?

In this annual liturgy rich in symbolism, Bishop Wack will gather with the priests serving in our diocese to renew their fellowship and commitment to priestly ministry. Additionally, at this Mass each year, the Bishop blesses the oil of the sick and the oil of catechumens and consecrates the holy chrism, all of which will enrich the sacramental life of the diocese in the coming year. All are welcome to attend the Chrism Mass this Tuesday. Or, watch the live stream at ptdiocese.org/chrismmass

Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence. Those aged 18-59 should only eat one full meal and two smaller meals, and those 14 and older abstain from meat, as we remember the death of Jesus on the cross.

HOLY WEEK: HOLY THURSDAY & GOOD FRIDAY

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week.

Holy Thursday is the last Mass celebrated until the Easter Vigil on Saturday evening. Holy Thursday marks the beginning of the Easter Triduum, a three-day period of solemn worship ending with Easter Sunday. During the Holy Thursday Mass, the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood is celebrated as we remember the Last Supper. Washing of the feet at Mass demonstrates humility and service, just as Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. At the end of Mass, the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the Monstrance and is available for adoration, as we await the passion and death of our Lord on Good Friday.

The service on <u>Good Friday</u> is a solemn day which commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus, marked by fasting, prayer, and reflection on his sacrifice. No Mass is celebrated, but rather a liturgy with veneration of the cross and communion from hosts that were consecrated on Holy Thursday. Despite the tragic nature of the passion and death



of Jesus, it is called "Good" because of the ultimate good that came from it—the redemption of humanity through Jesus' sacrifice.

We hope you will join us this Holy Week as we commemorate the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord.
