


November 1st Vigil & November 2nd: All Souls Day Mass

The St. Jude Novena is traditionally prayed from October 19th through October 27th, in preparation for his feast day on October 28th. We pray the St. Jude Novena to lead us in prayer for hope and strength during difficult times in our lives and in the lives of others. St. Jude sought to love the Lord through challenging times, so we strive to imitate this same unwavering faith.

How to pray the St. Jude Novena:

- 1.Make the Sian of the Cross
- 2. Pray the Our Father
- 3. Invoke St. Jude's Intercession: St. Jude, faithful servant, friend of Jesus, patron saint of lost causes and of hope, pray for me (say your intentions)
- 4. Pray the St. Jude Novena Prayer
- 5. Say one decade of the rosary
- 6. Make the Sign of the Cross Repeat each day October 19-October 27.

St. Jude Novena Prayer

"St. Jude, you are the patron of the impossible. Pray for me and my intentions! O St. Jude, pray that God's grace and mercy will cover my intentions. Pray for the impossible if it is God's will. Pray that I may have the grace to accept God's holy will even if it is painful and difficult for me."
